Contest Guidelines

- 1. Permission to Appear Online:** By submitting this video, all team members are consenting to use of this video on the fundraising website, on social media, and in KEF communications. All team members participating allow for pictures and/or videos of their practice or other team events to be used for promotional material in print or social media as promotion for this event. All team members must be included on the registration form including their email addresses.
- 2. Social Distancing and Masks:** It is the sole responsibility of performing groups to adhere to current COVID-19 guidelines with regard to social distancing and masks. If guidelines are not followed, the KEF Fundraising Committee reserves the right to disqualify and not post the act.
- 3. Video Content and Quality:** All videos should be filmed in "landscape mode" in as high definition as possible. Videos may be edited and/or effects added as desired. Teams should have fun and be creative! Costumes, makeup, and dancing are welcome.
- 4. Time Limit:** The maximum time permitted for each performance is three minutes. Mash-ups and edited songs work well.
- 5. Appropriateness:** All submissions should be G/PG-rated. The KEF Fundraising Committee reserves the right to cancel registration if the Committee feels the act is inappropriate or offensive to others. If an inappropriate or offensive act is performed the Committee reserves the right to disqualify and not post the act.
- 6. Voting:** Dollars raised will count as votes for this performance. Teams are not required to make a donation themselves or raise a specific amount of money. However, sharing your video widely means more votes for your team and more money raised for KEF. The Fundraising Committee suggests a donation of \$20 by team members to start the fundraising, but this is not required.
- 7. Submissions:** Teams or performers may submit or participate in more than one video; however, each video's votes/fundraising total will be counted separately. Videos should be uploaded to the link provided along with a completed copy of the Team Registration form. All submissions must be received by November 1, 2020 at 11:59pm.
- 8. Judging:** The voting website will be live Monday, November 9, 2020. At this time, teams will be able to share the link to the fundraising website and individual performances. Voting will remain live for one week, closing on Sunday, November 15, 2020 at 11:59pm. Teams are encouraged to share their fundraising links on social media and through email.
- 9. Results:** Winners in each entry category will be determined based on the number of votes collected and announced on November 21. In the event of a tie, a tie-breaker will be determined by a coin toss or similar game of chance. All decisions will be final.
- 10. Payments:** For the Class of 2021, scholarships will be paid at the end of the 2020-2021 school year with other KEF scholarships and will be paid to the higher education institution which the student(s) will be attending. Proof of enrollment will be required. Scholarship winnings will be split equally among those in a group act. All other winnings will be awarded by December 31, 2020.
